Tolire is under the foot of Mount Gamalama, the highest volcano in North Maluku. The lake itself is composed of two pieces. Local people call Tolire as LargeTolire and Small Tolire. Those lakeshave theirs own uniqueness. This lake resembles a giant pan. From the upper edge to the surface of the lake water with a depth of about 50 meters and an area of about 5 hectares. While the depth of the lake itself until now unknown. Until now no one has measure the depth of this lake yet. Freshwater in Large Tolireis home to a wide variety of fish. However, local people have no one dared fishing or bathing in the lake. Tolire under the foot of Mount Gamalama holds a sad story. According to legend, Tolire divided into two parts, namely largeTolire and smallTolire. Any breach of the lake due to the negligence of a father to his daughter. The father raped his daughter. After the heartbreaking tragedy, landslides and overflowing lakes. As a result, the village Takome sink. Surprisingly, after the receding, lake is divided into two parts. Great Tolire estimated as a manifestation of the father. Meanwhile, a small Tolire is a manifestation of the child.

The distance from large Tolire and small Tolire is just 200 meters away. Small Tolire is near the beach. The water is brackish, because it was close to the sea, which is about 50 meters. When visiting large Tolire, the visitors should automatically pass small Tolire.

Unfortunately, the beauty of the great Tolire is more tempting than small Tolire. Most tourists and residents choose big Tolire as tourist attractions.

Large Tolire resembles a giant pan, with an area of about five hectares and a depth of 50 meters. Another uniqueness is big Tolire'swater is green in dry season and brown in the rainy season.

Mystery this time coming from a small town located in the eastern part of Indonesia, that is the Capital of North Maluku, Ternate. As one of the cities in Indonesia that has many legends, Ternate has a lot of its own uniqueness. One of the unique nature created in Ternate namely Tolire commonly called Gam Tolire Jaha which means pit village drowned. Travelling in the city of Ternate is incomplete if it does not stop in the area of nature tourism. Beautiful panorama presented in the region makes this lake became one selling travel in Ternate town visited by many tourists. Expanse of coconut trees along the left side of the lake. In front, Gamalama mountain is standing firmly, while on the right side is the overlay of golden teak plants and Jambulangtrees (typical fruit of Ternate) in front of it. On the west side, or behind when facing the lake, a row of palm trees and the extent of sea and sunset (when the afternoon) becomes the beautiful scenery of its own. But, sometimes, tourists who come to Tolire, not because they want to enjoy the beautiful scenery. They generally come to enjoy a million mysteries that are stored in the lake. It is called Gam Jaha, because supposedly, according to legend, in hundreds of years ago before standing kingdom of Ternate, the lake is a village.

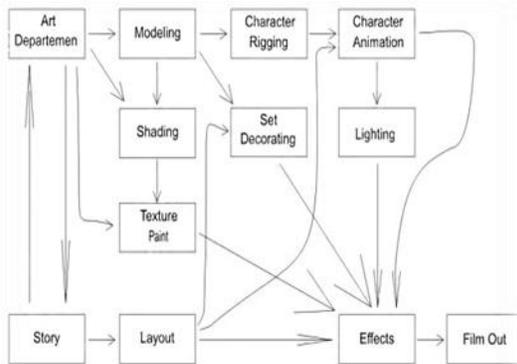


Figure: An Analysis of Animation Film Making
